Background:

In the last decade of the 20th century, Peace Support Operations (PSO) had been given a completely new design. Transformations to peace-building missions were directed to changes in their structure, establishment of new components and addition of new tasks. Their civilian component was strengthened with civilian police functions (CIVPOL), monitoring of elections, provision of humanitarian aid, monitoring of human rights implementation, Disarmament, Demobilization & Reintegration (DDR). Just a few years later development and democratization programs and Security Sector Reform (SSR) were introduced to the core of peace-building missions. Being members of international community, bound by alliances as well as their own security and defense strategies and agendas, countries of the region are equally expected to contribute to this global effort. Yet, with effective provision of security standing as one of preconditions to reconstruction and development, actors of PSO are facing increasing difficulties in planning their SSR related agenda.

Purpose and objectives:

To provide participants with insights into planning and implementing an SSR program in a PSO environment, with the specific objectives of:

- reaching an understanding of its theoretical and conceptual underpinnings, especially in regard to the whole of governance (WoG) approach,
- recognizing context and background; challenges and key facets; drivers and spoilers of reform,
- mapping key actors of reform, including non-statutory ones,
- drafting an action plan for implementing an SSR program in a post-conflict environment,
- to set the ground for regional support for co-operation in the area of SSR within the context of PSO,
- to support PSO capacity and integrity building in the context of alignment of national structures, policies and practices, both at national and international level.
